### **Indications**

**Chickens:** As an aid in the prevention of coccidiosis caused by *Eimeria necatrix*, *E. tenella*, *E. Acervulina*, *E. brunetti*, *E. Mivati* and *E. maxima* in broiler chickens and replacement chickens intended for use as caged layers.

**Turkeys:** For the prevention of coccidiosis in growing turkeys caused by *Eimeria adenoeides, E. Meleagrimitis* and *E. Gallopavonis.* 

**Quail:** For the prevention of coccidiosis in Bobwhite quail caused by *Eimeria dispersa* and *E. lettyae*.

## **Use Programs**

**Important:** Do not feed undiluted. Must be thoroughly mixed in feeds before use.

**Chickens:** Feed continuously as the sole ration a complete feed containing 90 to 110 grams of monensin per ton. Do not feed to laying chickens. Do not feed to chickens over 16 weeks of age.

**Turkeys**: Feed continuously to growing turkeys as the sole ration from one day of age a complete feed containing 54 to 90 grams of monensin per ton depending upon the severity of coccidiosis exposure. Bobwhite Quail: Feed continuously as the sole ration a complete feed containing 73 grams of monensin per ton.

### Mixing Directions - Bobwhite Quail:

Thoroughly mix the following amount of Coban 60 with a sufficient quantity of unmedicated feed to make one ton of complete quail feed to provide 73 grams of monensin per ton.

**Feeding Directions:** For Bobwhite quail, feed continuously as the sole ration.
